Best local attractions

- The River Esk (direct access from the campsite) with some of the best wild swimming pools in the area.
- The Ravenglass and Eskdale Railway or "Laal Ratty" as we call it, miniature railway from Boot to Ravenglass a must for your visit to Eskdale, walking distance from the campsite. Cafe top and bottom. Dog friendly.
